### **Programs**

#### **Juvenile Diversion Program**

The Juvenile Diversion Program works with probation referred first time offenders who must complete certain requirements of probation (i.e. Community Service, Anger Management Classes, Independent Living Skills Classes, Case Management, etc...). Staff works with the family to help them understand the Juvenile court process and provide support and guidance in order to assure that all probation requirements are met. #### **Academic Component**

Our academic hour, "Power Hour," is conducted Monday through Thursday from 3:30 – 4:30 and provides the youth with an opportunity to complete homework assignments with the help of tutors.
